## **Regulation Impact Statement for Brake Assist Systems**

I am writing in relation to the attached draft Regulation Impact Statement (RIS) prepared by the Department of Infrastructure and Transport proposing amendments to Vehicle Standard (Australian Design Rule 31/02 – Brake Systems for Passenger Cars) 2009 and Vehicle Standard (Australian Design Rule 35/03 – Commercial Vehicle Brake Systems) 2009 to mandate Brake Assist Systems for new light passenger vehicles and light commercial vehicles.

I am satisfied that the draft RIS meets the Government's best practice regulation requirements, in particular that:

- the problem being addressed and the objectives of government action are well articulated;
- all feasible options are considered;
