Regulation Impact Statement – Control of Light Commercial Vehicle Stability

Thank you for your letter dated 8 August 2013 regarding the Regulation Impact Statement (RIS) for Control of Light Commercial Vehicle Stability.

The RIS contains an adequate level of analysis and meets the Government's best practice regulation requirements. We note that the RIS has been formally certified as required by the best practice regulation requirements and is in a form meeting the Australian Government's *Web Content Accessibility Guidelines*.

The Office of Best Practice Regulation (OBPR) maintains a RIS website and the Government requires that RISs be posted within 5 business days of a regulatory decision being publicly announced. Accordingly, we would appreciate you advising us when a decision on this proposal is announced. The website provides a public comment facility on RISs posted on the site. The OBPR moderates this facility for offensive content but does not moderate debate.
