Dear Mr McNamara

Further to my letter of 23 July 2014 regarding the Regulation Impact Statement (RIS - 16234) prepared for a proposed mandatory code of conduct for grain export terminals, please find attached a revised RIS. The regulatory burden to business, community organisations and/or individuals has been quantified using the Regulatory Burden Measurement framework. These have been agreed with your office.

I believe the department has addressed the issues raised in Mr Tony Simovski's letter of 25 July 2014 and that the RIS consistent with best-practice regulation requirements and the ten principles for Australian Government policy makers. In particular we have clarified the problem and the impacts of the various options, particularly option 4. I submit the enclosed certified RIS to the Office of Best Practice Regulation for formal final assessment.

To ensure decision makers have the opportunity to select option 3-which requires the Minister for Agriculture, the Hon Barnaby Joyce MP, to obtain final policy approval from the Prime Minister by 22 August 2014–I seek your urgent consideration and response.
