## Telecommunications (Section of Telecommunications Industry – Cabling Service Operators) Determination 2015

I am writing to the Office of Best Practice Regulation regarding the *Telecommunications* (Section of Telecommunications Industry – Cabling Service Operators) Determination 2015 which, as per the Legislative Instruments Act 2003, had been scheduled to sunset in 2015. The ACMA has since decided that this instrument is to be remade without significant amendment.

The Australian Communications and Media Authority certifies that the *Telecommunications* (Section of Telecommunications Industry – Cabling Service Operators) Determination 2015 is operating effectively and efficiently, and that as such, a Regulation Impact Statement is not required for this regulation to continue.

The assessment that the regulation is operating effectively and efficiently has been informed by a consultation process which involved key industry stakeholders over the period 15 December 2014 to 2 February 2014.
