Radiocommunications (Communication with Space Objects) Class Licence 1998

I am writing to the Office of Best Practice Regulation (OBPR) regarding the *Radiocommunications (Communication with Space Objects) Class Licence 1998* which, as per the *Legislative Instruments Act 2003*, had been scheduled to sunset on 1 October 2015.

The ACMA certifies that the *Radiocommunications (Communication with Space Objects) Class Licence 1998* is operating effectively and efficiently, and that as such, a Regulation Impact Statement is not required for this regulation to continue in its current form. The OBPR reference number is 18253.

The assessment that the regulation is operating effectively and efficiently has been informed by a consultation process which involved consulting with the general public over the period 21 April 2015 to 29 June 2015.
