Regulation Impact Statement – final assessment second pass

I am writing in relation to the attached Regulation Impact Statement (RIS) prepared for the Deregulation of the Student Visa Programme (OBPR No. 18083). The regulatory burden to business, community organisations and/or individuals has been quantified and offsets have been identified and quantified using the Business Cost Calculator. These have been agreed with your office.

I am satisfied that the RIS addresses the concerns raised in your letter of 27 November 2015. Specifically, I note that the RIS:

- considers how the current arrangements affect competition in the market and the potential benefits to students from any improvements in competition.
- clearly demonstrates why the preferred option is considered to be the best of the options assessed.
