**Do Not Call Register Regulations 2006 – Sunsetting**

I am writing to the Office of Best Practice Regulation (OBPR) regarding the *Do Not Call Register Regulations 2006*, which under the *Legislative Instruments Act 2003*, have been scheduled to sunset on 1 April 2017. It has been decided that the instrument is to be remade without significant amendment.

The Department of Communications and the Arts certifies that the *Do Not Call Register Regulations 2006* are operating effectively and efficiently, and that therefore a Regulation Impact Statement is not required for the regulations to be remade. The assessment that the regulations are operating effectively and efficiently has been informed by a consultation process which involved the Australian Communications and Media Authority, the Association for Data-driven Marketing and Advertising and the Australian Communications Consumer Action Network, over the period April to July 2016.
