## Regulation Impact Statement - Final Assessment - My Health Record System

Thank you for submitting a certified Regulation Impact Statement (RIS) examining the impacts of the introduction of opt-out arrangements for the My Health Record system for final assessment by the Office of Best Practice Regulation (OBPR) on 24 February 2017.
