Regulation Impact Statement – Second Pass Assessment – Working Holiday Makers

Thank you for submitting the Regulation Impact Statement (RIS) for the above proposal to the Office of Best Practice Regulation (OBPR) for second-pass final assessment on 7 October 2016. I note the RIS has been formally certified at the Deputy Secretary level consistent with best practice.

The OBPR's final assessment is that the Treasury is compliant with the Government's RIS requirements.

The RIS has not been assessed as best practice with the Government's RIS requirements as a significant and major policy decision on the proposal was announced on 27 September 2016 that was not informed by an updated RIS.

The OBPR should be consulted if the RIS is amended.

The OBPR maintains a RIS website. We would appreciate you advising us when decisions on this proposal are finalised, and forwarding a final copy of the RIS in *Microsoft Word .doc* format in a form meeting the Australian Government's *Web Content Accessibility Guidelines*.
