Sunsetting legislative instrument - Health Insurance (Approved Pathology Undertakings) Approval 2002

Further to OBPR's advice on 30 August 2017 to the Department regarding the sunsetting legislative instrument titled Health Insurance (Approved Pathology Undertakings) Approval 2002 (the Pathology Undertakings), I am writing to advise that the Department of Health certifies that the Pathology Undertakings has been operating effectively and efficiently to date. The department has undertaken a comprehensive review of the Pathology Undertakings and is proposing the instrument is remade. As the instrument is being remade without any materially significant changes, a Regulation Impact Statement is not required (OBPR ID 22750).

The assessment that the regulation is operating effectively and efficiently has been informed by a consultation process with the Department of Human Services, who manages the administrative arrangements relating to the accreditation status of pathology laboratories.
