## OBPR Ref. 22934: Certification of Independent Review 'Priorities for Australia's biosecurity system'.

I am writing to certify that the attached report 'Priorities for Australia's biosecurity system: An independent review of the capacity of the national biosecurity system and its underpinning Intergovernmental Agreement' (the review) was informed by a process and analysis equivalent to a Regulatory Impact Statement (RIS).

I certify that the review has adequately addressed all seven RIS questions for the purposes of the Australian Government's consideration of the review panel's recommendations.

The regulatory burden to business, community organisations or individuals has been quantified using the Australian Government's Regulatory Burden Measurement framework. Regulatory costings have been agreed with your office and are provided below. In total, the biosecurity measures brought forward by the government as part of the national response to the review will achieve regulatory savings of \$836,638.
