Australian Human Rights Commission Regulations 1989

I am writing to the Office of Best Practice Regulation (OBPR) regarding the *Australian Human Rights Commission Regulations 1989* (the AHRC Regulations) which, as per the *Legislation Act 2003*, is scheduled to sunset on 1 October 2019.

The Attorney-General's Department certifies that the AHRC Regulations are operating effectively and efficiently, and that therefore a Regulation Impact Statement is not required for these regulations to be remade.

The assessment that the regulations are operating effectively and efficiently has been informed by a consultation process which involved the Australian Human Rights Commission and relevant agencies and stakeholders, over a six week period.
