**Broadcasting Services (Primary Commercial Television Broadcasting Service) Declaration 2010**

I am writing to the Office of Best Practice Regulation (OBPR) regarding the Broadcasting Services (Primary Commercial Television Broadcasting Service) Declaration 2010 which, as per the *Legislation Act 2003*, had been scheduled to sunset on 1 October 2020. However, it has been decided that the instrument is to be remade without significant amendment. Minor changes, verified with the relevant industry bodies, will be made to ensure the instrument has up-to-date information.

The ACMA certifies that the Broadcasting Services (Primary Commercial Television Broadcasting Service) Declaration 2010 is operating effectively and efficiently and that therefore a Regulation Impact Statement is not required for this regulation to be remade.

The assessment that the regulation is operating effectively and efficiently has been informed by two consultation processes. The first was a targeted consultation process which involved licensees whose services were listed in Schedules 1 and 3 of the instrument. These licensees were representatives from the following broadcasters:

- > Seven Network
- > Nine Network
- > Network 10
- > WIN
- > Southern Cross Austereo
- > Prime Media
- > Imparja
- > Central Digital Television

The second was a public consultation, over the period 4 May to 10 July 2020.
