I certify that the attached independent review of the Product Stewardship for Oil (PSO) scheme has undertaken a process and analysis equivalent to an Impact Analysis (IA). I certify that this document adequately addresses all seven IA questions, and is submitted to the Office of Impact Analysis for the purposes of a final policy decision.

I am satisfied that the scope of the problem and the recommendations identified in the certified review are substantially the same as the identified problem and recommendations in the policy proposal to change the PSO levy that forms part of the Minister for the Environment and Water's portfolio budget submission.

I further certify that fewer than three policy options are examined because the recommendation is a revenue raising measure.

The regulatory burden to business, community organisations or individuals is quantified using the Australian Government's *Regulatory Burden Measurement* framework and is provided below.
