Impact Analysis – Second Pass Final Assessment – Online Safety Industry Standard for Relevant Electronic Services and Designated Internet Services for Class 1A and 1B material

Thank you for your letter of 16 May 2024 submitting an Impact Analysis (IA) for formal Second Pass Final Assessment. I note the IA has been formally certified at the Deputy Secretary level consistent with the Australian Government Guide to Policy Impact Analysis.

I appreciate the eSafety Commission's constructive engagement on the IA. The Office of Impact Analysis' (OIA) assessment is that the quality of the analysis in the IA is exemplary.

The process followed to develop the IA has been of a particularly high standard. The IA contains strong responses to each of the seven IA questions, and of particular note is the:

- clear articulation of the problem through a use of quantification where possible, together with the application of a method that draws from international experiences to establish compliance costs; and
- explanation of how stakeholder views shaped the options and informed the impact analysis.

Next steps

After a final decision has been announced, I ask that your agency work with the OIA to finalise this analysis for public release. This includes providing a copy of the IA in Word and PDF format for web accessibility purposes. The IA must be included in any Explanatory Memorandum or Statement

giving effect to the proposals in the IA.
