Radiocommunications Licence Conditions (Temporary Community Broadcasting Licence) Determination 2015 and Radiocommunications Licence Conditions (Broadcasting Licence) Determination 2015

I am writing to the Office of Impact Analysis (OIA) regarding the *Radiocommunications Licence Conditions (Temporary Community Broadcasting Licence) Determination 2015* and *Radiocommunications Licence Conditions (Broadcasting Licence) Determination 2015* (together, the determinations), which, as per the *Legislation Act 2003*, have been scheduled to sunset on the 1 April 2025 and the 1 October 2025 respectively.

The ACMA has decided to remake the determinations and combine them into a single instrument. The instrument will otherwise be remade with only minor changes.

The ACMA certifies that the determinations are operating effectively and efficiently and therefore Impact Analysis is not required for this legislation to be remade. The assessment that the legislation is operating effectively and efficiently has been informed by a public consultation, over the period 19 December 2024 to 14 January 2025.

I also note that the regulatory burden to people, business or community organisations has been quantified using the Australian Government's Regulatory Burden Measurement framework. These are provided below.
