Certification of Impact Analysis Equivalent – NDIS provider registration reforms

Thank you for your letter of 19 March 2026 certifying the Supplementary Analysis *NDIS Provider Registration Rules changes* along with the five publicly available reviews constitute a process and analysis equivalent to an Impact Analysis (IA) – the reviews being:

- Royal Commission into Violence, Abuse, Neglect and Exploitation of People with Disability;
- Independent Review into the National Disability Insurance Scheme;
- NDIS Provider and Worker Registration Taskforce;
- NDIS Commission's Own Motion Inquiry into Aspects of Supported Accommodation, and
- NDIS Commission's Own Motion Inquiry into how platform providers operate in the NDIS market.

The Office of Impact Analysis (OIA) acknowledges the certification as an Impact Analysis Equivalent (IAE). Under the *Australian Government Guide to Policy Impact Analysis*, the OIA does not assess the adequacy of the analysis in an IAE but does assess whether the options analysed in the certified documents are relevant to the policy proposal. The OIA also assesses the IAE for the coverage of the seven IA questions and whether the IAE or certification letter identifies regulatory costs. The OIA's assessment is that the options analysed in the IAE are sufficiently relevant to the proposal.

We ask you advise us when a final decision has been announced and provide a copy of the IAE in a form meeting the Government's accessibility requirements. The OIA will publish the IAE, along with your certification, on the OIA's website. The IAE must be included in any Explanatory Memorandum or Statement giving effect to the proposals in the IAE, as stipulated in the *User Guide to the Australian Government Guide to Policy Impact Analysis*.
